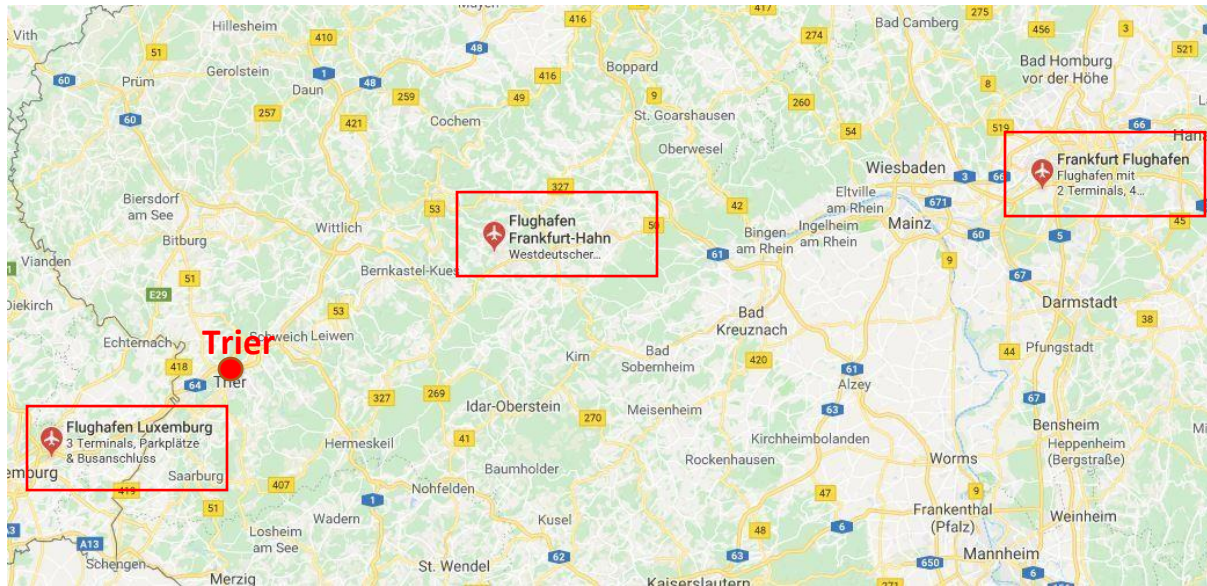


How to get to Trier

1. By Plane



The nearest airport is Luxemburg. Slightly further away is Frankfurt/Hahn or Frankfurt/Main (as indicated on the map above). Other options are Köln/Bonn and Saarbrücken. Public transport to Trier is available at all these airports.

Arrival via Luxemburg Airport

35 minutes by car, the bus takes a little longer.

Flib Travel International SA, tel. +49 180 15 07 570, operates a regular shuttle-bus connection from Luxemburg Airport to Trier. Advance booking at www.flibco.com or by email: info@flibco.com.

Bus 117 [Voyages Emile Weber](http://www.voyages-emile-weber.com) goes several times a day on Monday to Friday between Luxemburg and Trier.

The regular city bus goes from Luxemburg Airport to Luxemburg train station and from there the train to Trier (Hauptbahnhof). More information is available on the Deutsche Bahn homepage: www.bahn.de.

Arriving via Frankfurt-Hahn Airport

about 1 hour from Trier

There is a direct shuttle-bus connection from Frankfurt-Hahn Airport to Trier (Hauptbahnhof).

Fares for the shuttle bus (from Trier, bus stop Main Station, Bahnhofplatz in front of station, bus platform 1):

One-way: from € 5.00 to a maximum of € 22.00 (according to the reservation period).

Connection to Trier by taxi: about € 100.00 (one way)
