Data Policy, for The Philosophical Society at OUDCE

- 1. All members' personal data is held securely.
- 2. Such data is used solely for the purpose of communicating with members and sending copies of the annual Review.
- 3. A subset of the data (name and town/city) is shared with OUDCE administration, in order to support the ten percent discount for members.
- 4. A list of members' names (with town/city and country), is published annually in the Review.
- 5. The data is not shared with any other third parties.
- 6. The PhilSoc website does not use cookies, except for maintaining member login session while that session lasts. This session cookie contains only an encryption of the session's IP address.
- 7. All email communications with members are either addressed individually or use 'blind copies'.
- 8. Except when explicitly authorised, the Society website does not and will not show any personal email addresses.
- 9. When members leave the Society their data is held for eighteen further months, and is then deleted.
- 10. Members are free to request deletion of some or all of their data (though this may have an unavoidable impact on services being provided).
- 11. When members are reminded by email to renew their membership, a link is provided to allow members to securely review, and if necessary modify, their personal data held by the Society.
- 12. In the event of a data breach, all members will be notified of this by email. Members will also be notified of any change in the data policy.
